"Juicy Citrus Pitcher"

1. Dip your sponge into water, squeeze it out, and wipe off your entire pitcher (inside and out, rim, top and bottom) to remove bisque dust.

- 2. To trace citrus design onto the pitcher:
 - -- Place a piece of tissue paper over the citrus drawings.
 - -- Trace the citrus onto the tissue paper with your #2 pencil.
 - -- Trace the citrus onto the pitcher itself using tissue paper and a Sharpie marker.
- Paint the citrus fruit THREE COATS of color.
 (Let each coat dry completely before adding the next.)



- 4. Using a squeeze bottle or a tiny paint brush (whichever feels most comfortable), outline each citrus fruit with the coordinating deeper color. NOTE: If you outline with a tiny paintbrush, do three coats for solid coverage. If you outline with a squeeze bottle, do ONE coat since it goes on thick, it counts as 3 coats.
- 5. The color combinations are:

LEMONS: Yella Bout It fruit, rimmed with Sunkissed

LIMES: Limelight fruit, rimmed with Sour Apple

ORANGES: Jack-O-Lantern fruit, rimmed with Orange-a-Peel

BREAK TIME: Allow your fruit to thoroughly dry while you enjoy a snack!

- 6. Paint the inside of the pitcher and the handle 3 coats of MY BLUE HEAVEN. Let each coat dry before adding the next.
- 7. LAST STEP: Use a squeeze bottle filled with COTTON TAIL to create the "section" lines on the citrus.

Sign your pottery with a paintbrush or glaze pencil, and bring it (and your completed tag) up to the desk.
